Unauthorized Use of Club Building

It has come to the attention of the Board the club building might have been used for unauthorized activities.

Any activity other than member training or obedience, rally, and agility classes must be presented to the Board for approval. The Board meets immediately after every club meeting on the 2nd Tuesday of each month.

It is the responsibility of each club member to adhere to accepted policies and practices of the club and to monitor and report any unauthorized use of the club building and agility field to Board members or club Officers.

The use of club facilities and resources is reserved for club members only with appropriate approval. Members may not invite non-members to train at club facilities. Further, it is not appropriate to use club facilities for private gain. A release is necessary for all individuals – member or non-member – before training on club premises. Inappropriate and unauthorized use of club resources could be grounds for suspension of membership or expulsion from the club.

If you have any questions regarding appropriate use of club facilities, please address your concerns at the next Club or Board meeting.

Unfinished Business:

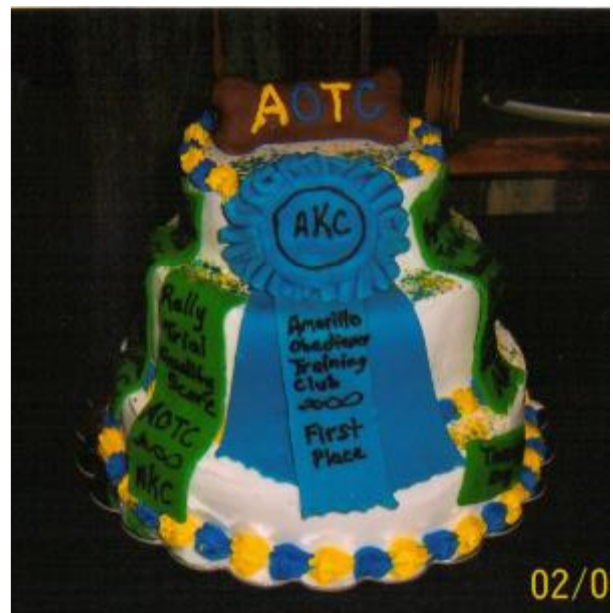
Strategic Planning: get a clear idea of membership levels; look at updating Yahoo group; Carol Brand is working on a survey.
