Stacy Bols opened Proof Positive Dog Training in 2007. She has 18 years of dog training experience and more than 10 years of agility training experience.

Her first agility dog, Kramer, an Miniature Schnauzer, did not start agility training until the age of 8 and he still finished his MACH and ADCh in his career.

Stacy's next 12" dog, Krusher (miniature schnauzer), is a dual venue champion with his MACH 5, ADCH-Silver and LAA Silver. Stacy and Krusher were 2011 AKC Agility Nationals 12" Finalist and participated in the 2011 AKC Invitational also making the finals in Orlando, FL. In 2012 he was a finalist in Performance Grand Prix finishing 4th overall and was a 2014 IFCS World Team Member.

Kassie, Stacy's rescue Border Collie, was a 2011 and 2012 AKC Agility National 20" Finalist. Kassie is also a dual venue champion with both a MACH and an ADCh Bronze and LAA-Bronze

Introducing !!! Den Schwarzen Wirbel Purely Froggy Feelin "Kermit"

Kermit is Stacy's 2 year old miniature schnauzer that competes in agility in 4 different venues: AKC, USDAA, ASCA, and UKI.

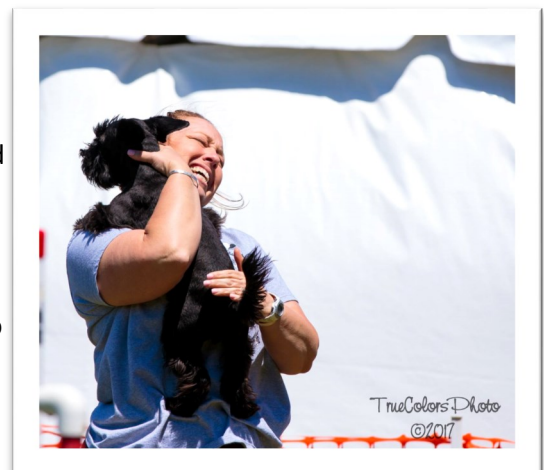
She began trialing in AKC in June of 2016 and in less then a year of showing Kermit has moved up through Novice, Open and Excellent and in only 4 shows of all Masters she has managed to qualify for the 2018 AKC National Agility Championship. She has also qualified for 2018 European Open Tryouts and 2018 AKC Agility World Team Tryouts. In her first month of AKC Masters, Kermit earned her way into the Quarter 1 Bad Dog Agility Breed Power 10 debuting at #6 of all 12" Miniature Schnauzers.

In only 5 USDAA trials, she worked her way though Starters, Advanced and into Masters. In her limited trialing she has earned all the qualifications for 2017 Cynosports including 2 Grand Prix vouchers for winning the class.

In both UKI and ASCA she has worked her way up to the highest level and is working on the Qs needed to earn those championships.

"Although she is still very young and has plenty of baby dog moments, she has already exceeded all my expectations for her career up to this point. She is a blast to run and always puts 100% into every course. She has challenged me to be a better trainer and handler and hope that as we grow together the journey only gets better."

Known for her signature "squeak" while running, she is a hard one to miss on the agility course.


