Amarillo Obedience Training Club (AOTC), the facility, the event secretary, trial chairman, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators. AOTC is not responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the site.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This test is a non-competitive pass/fail evaluation of dog's ability to exhibit self-control in a rural farm setting.
- The FDC test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program. Bitches in season are not eligible to participate.
- **Dogs must be on a leash at all times unless confined in a crate, kennel, or vehicle.**
- Dogs must wear a secure, well fitting, flat collar during the test evaluation.
- The trial will use concurrent tests with block scheduling. There will be 10-15 dogs for each on time block. Each of the 10-15 dogs will run their first run and as soon as the entire block is finished, the same 10-15 dogs will run their second run. At that point, that block of dogs is through for the day. **Running order will be determined by a random draw conducted on October 2nd at 8 p.m. at the AOTC Training Building.**
- Trial Hour are 9:00 am until 4:00 pm or until all runs are completed. Dogs of judges and workers will test one hour prior to the first block of exhibitors. The first block of dogs should be checked in and in the staging area at 8:30 am.
- There is no on-site RV parking.
- All exhibitors are responsible for reading and understanding the regulations for Farm Dog Certification.
- For test elements requiring livestock, three sheep will be used.
- Handlers can use verbal cues, hand signals, and praise, provided it is not excessive in the opinion of the judges.
- Dogs may attempt each test element no more than two times.
- Dogs must pass all elements of the test and overall assessment during the same test to qualify.
- Dogs must qualify under two different judges in order to be awarded the FDC suffix title.
- The judge may discontinue testing if he/she determines the dog is too fearful, under duress, or the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs, or persons on the farm.
